INTRODUCTION

In the framework of the TAP-AIS project, FAO's Research and

Extension Unit (OINR) in collaboration with the Asia-Pacific Association of Agricultural Research Institutions (APAARI) and the Asia-Pacific Islands and Rural Advisory Services Network (APIRAS) are organizing a regional Training of Trainers (ToT) on AIS concepts and methods, targeting trainers and faculty from Asia-Pacific.

The main objectives of the ToT are to:

- 1. raise awareness on AIS approaches, and
- 2. introduce participants to the TAP common framework on capacity development for AIS and its set of accompanying tools for capacity development and strengthening agrifood systems in their respective countries.

Agricultural Innovation System (AIS)

It is a network of actors (individuals, organizations and enterprises), together with supporting institutions and policies in the agriculture and related sectors that bring existing or new products, processes and forms of organization into social and economic use.

 capacity to innovate effectively.
